On March 1<sup>st</sup>, version 3.0 of [www.Obrerofiel.com](http://www.Obrerofiel.com) (Spanish ministry resources) was launched. In mid-March, a Spanish website to recruit online missionaries was launched ([www.misioneroenlinea.com](http://www.misioneroenlinea.com)). In late April, the online follow-up course for new believers was launched (<http://escuela.obrerofiel.com>). During the last week of April, we had several people promoting the online missionary program at the MAGNA missions conference in Guatemala at the CAM Seminary (SETECA).

All of these activities have been focused toward accomplishing three goals for this year.

- ❑ Locate 1 evangelical church in every city of 500,000+ people in the Western Hemisphere.
- ❑ Recruit 25 community leaders to oversee online missionaries.
- ❑ Recruit 500 Spanish-speaking online missionaries
