HOPE Coffee:

Recently, I've spent some time studying some statistics from George Barna and Probe Ministries about the future of the American Church. Their results revealed that only 9% of Americans are truly born again believers and that a shockingly low percentage (3.9% of adults and 0.8% of teenagers) have a true biblical worldview. These numbers cause us concern as we look to the future of missionaries being sent from the US. The US is becoming a needy mission field. So how does our role intersect with these stats? I believe that through the message of HOPE Coffee, we can positively influence churches across America concerning their involvement in missions. Pray that God would use these opportunities to challenge and change many churches toward a true biblical worldview.

Our goal this year is to quadruple our gross sales from last year. In order to grow our coffee sales and the influence of HOPE Coffee and missions, we are serving free HOPE Coffee to church leaders at a variety of conferences this year. In February, we were privileged to serve free HOPE Coffee to 150 church leaders at Dallas Theological Seminary and 2,500 church leaders in Austin, Texas. In March, we served 500 students at Dallas Theological Seminary as well as 500 church leaders in Southlake, Texas. There are three remaining large conferences still to come this year through which we will be inviting churches to join the HOPE Partners program. July - 800 church worship leaders in Dallas; October - 3,000 believers in Seattle; November - 2,500 church leaders in Dallas.
