Pray that I keep the above purpose in mind when the daily grind of decisions weigh upon me (managing cash flow and donating profits, ordering more coffee from the coffee roasters, scheduling trucks to pick up and deliver the coffee, ordering new labels, finding volunteers to help promote HOPE Coffee at conferences, making sales phone calls to churches, encouraging our volunteers who ship the orders, entering the invoices, paying the bills, and following up with our sales staff). We are so *blessed* with a HOPE Coffee Team of 8 people that serve together to make the business and ministry possible.

After almost 10 months of working through the details of a HOPE Coffee Bar at Dallas Theological Seminary (DTS), God is opening a door for us to launch in early January 2014! We are *thankful* for the open door and ability to partner with Thornhill Catering, who is currently leasing the kitchen facility at DTS. We are praying for connections with baristas whom we can hire to manage the HOPE Coffee Bar and help promote both HOPE Coffee and Camino Global. *Pray* that this unique method would be beneficial for HOPE Coffee to gain an entrance into churches across the USA and that Camino Global would be able to recruit new missionaries from the connections made at the DTS HOPE Coffee Bar.
