2003 will be an exciting year for us as we expand our family, extend our ministry, and encourage our neighbors to accept Christ.

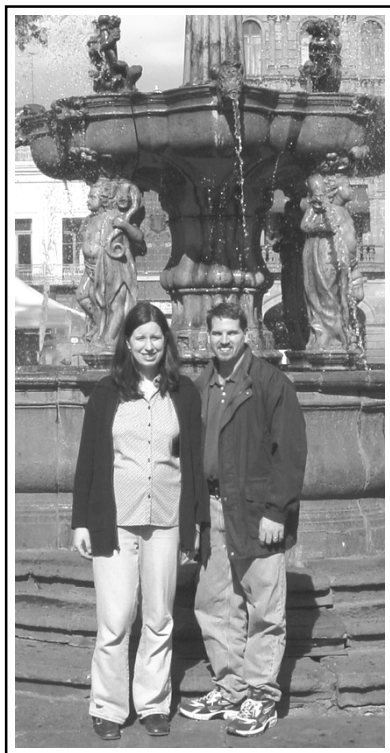
FAMILY

MEXICO TRIP

Jennifer and I had an opportunity to travel to Mexico City and Puebla, Mexico during the week of January 6th-10th. The trip was a wonderful time of getting to know many of the CAM Missionaries, seeing their victories, hearing about their struggles, and seeing how God provides. We heard many stories of sowing the gospel, watering the souls, and reaping the harvest of Eternal Life. We also experienced the culture and the food (it was fabulous – and no, we didn't get sick!)



Before we left on the trip we asked our neighbor (Randy) to pick up our mail. (This is the neighbor that we have invited to church and has been coming for the last 6 weeks) He was glad to help out and put his daughters to the task of retrieving our mail. When we returned, he brought our mail over to us, and we had about a 40-minute discussion about Christianity, God, Jesus and the need to understand what

Jesus did on the cross! Randy and his daughters would like to begin a Bible Study with us by going through the book, Stranger on the Road to Emmaus! We plan to begin sometime in February. Please pray that God would allow this Bible Study to be useful to them, challenging to them, and be a tool that God will use to cause them to accept Christ as their Savior.

While we were in Mexico, we visited Puebla Bible Seminary, ELA (CAM's Publishing House for Sunday School material, books, and devotionals), Puebla Christian School – an English day school for many missionary and/or government officials' kids, and saw many sites in Mexico City that were symbolic of the Catholicism that is a part of the Mexican lifestyle. We saw the Basilica of Guadalupe, which demonstrates the Mexican incorporation of the Aztec Indian religion of worshipping the moon god and the sun god into modern day Catholicism. On the door to the most modern cathedral, the sun god and the moon god were carved into the panels of the door. There were statues of Jesus with the sun god behind him. We even saw many paintings of God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit crowning Mary. All of these sights served to reinforce the spiritual need that exists in the Spanish-speaking countries that CAM serves.

He will be replacing 10 staff computers with new ones, upgrading 2 servers, taking a 3-day trip to Florida to help South American Mission setup a network domain, and implementing some new services for our missionaries. The software was used for CAM Center and for one of our seminaries in Guatemala City, Guatemala. He is again donating software this spring that we need to upgrade our servers. We thank God for the way he provides through His people!
