

The Masters Update

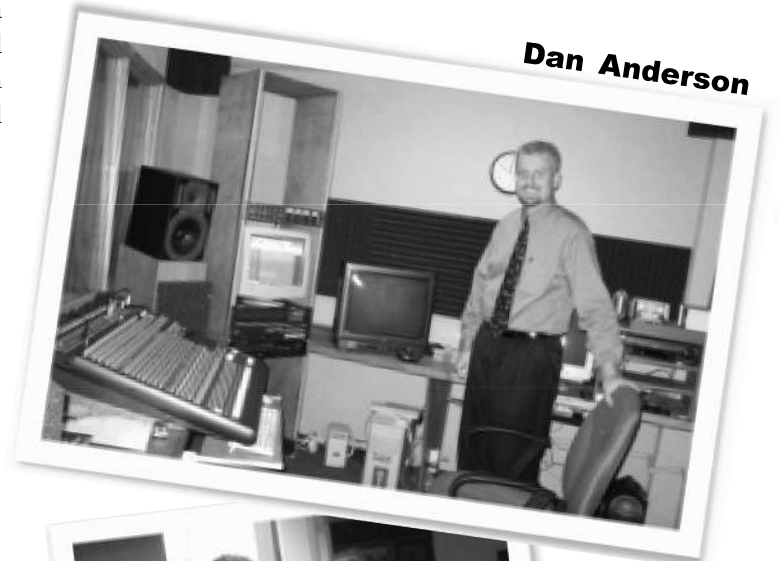
August 2004
