

LANGUAGE SCHOOL

We shared in our last prayer letter about our desire to learn Spanish, and our plans for a month of language school. We will spend the month of June studying Spanish at the Christian Spanish Academy located in Antigua, Guatemala. This school offers a unique, intensive approach to learning Spanish through individual tutoring.

We fly from Dallas to Guatemala City on June 1. Antigua is located about 45 minutes outside of the capital. Our family will stay in a small house on the grounds of a retired CAM missionary. This location is within walking distance of the language school. We will be challenged as we live "in the culture", buy food, and take taxis all with minimal Spanish! Pray that we would learn quickly and be able to make the most of this opportunity.
