We are partnering with BAMMatch.com and other ministry / business outlets to help us find interns and business professionals who might wish to get involved in BAM at CAM.

Obrerofiel.com: With nearly 100,000 visits a month to the website Obrerofiel.com and with over 35,000 people subscribing to the twice-a-week e-magazine that is sent out to encourage, equip and educate Latin believers around the world, we are launching the sustainability income model. Pray for Gloria, who is beginning to sell web advertisements on Obrerofiel.com to Spanish-speaking Christian companies. Our goal is to sell enough web ads to supply over 50% of the operating budget, which is approximately \$60,000 a year. We praise God that we can provide 5-6 Latin brothers and sisters in Christ in Mexico with jobs and ministries as they work for Obrerofiel.com. Pray for the thousands of Latin leaders around the world who are using this material to evangelize and disciple people around the world.

HOPE Coffee: This ministry / business continues to expand and grow as churches and businesses learn about how they can make in an eternal impact by drinking HOPE Coffee. As HOPE Coffee partners with the Honduran churches to reach out into their communities, together we have seen the following impact: repaired 9 roofs, poured 12 floors, constructed 6 pilas for water storage and cleaning, built one home for a widow and her family, and led one man to a relationship with Jesus Christ! Business as Mission: We are following God as he opens the doors of opportunity to pursue several opportunities. One is a sales force for a Christian owned organic fertilizer company in which we could employ Latins to take the Gospel to the nations as they are making relationships and selling this product in other countries. Another is an office building cleaning company that is owned by a Latin brother-in-Christ who would sub-contract work to a CAM owned cleaning company based in Dallas which would employ Latins and other believers. All of these opportunities are being pursued using our four criteria: 1) To create income for the operating budget of CAM International. 2) To provide ministry opportunities in which we can disciple Latins around the world. 3) To create jobs for Latins to take the Gospel to the nations. 4) To teach a biblical worldview of work as worship.
