Five New Believers in Honduras!

At the end of April 2021, Pastor Carlos Martinez of the New Jerusalem Church, met a family in El Aguacate, Honduras, who had lost their house in the hurricanes that went through in the fall of 2020. Several families and churches from that region helped this family find land and build a small home. However, this small home lacked a kitchen. So Pastor Carlos began to work with the family and use funds provided by HOPE Coffee to build them an enclosed kitchen. Throughout May and June, the gospel was shared with this family as they worked on the kitchen together with the church members. During the construction phase, the husband (Jose), the wife (Carminda) and their oldest daughter (Maria) all trusted in Jesus! The kitchen was finally completed on June 26th. Jose and Carminda are so eager to learn more about Jesus and the Bible that they are walking over 8 km (nearly 5 miles) each way to attend New Jerusalem Church. It takes them about 2 hours each Sunday to "walk" to church. During the middle of each week, volunteers from this church leave work in the mid-afternoon to make that 8 km walk to El Aguacate to lead a Bible Study and then walk back home. Many of Jose

This summer, the kids who attended the VBS program at our church here in Mesquite, Texas (Lake Ridge Bible Church) raised funds to build a house for Santos and Wendy, whose house in Honduras was destroyed in the 2020 hurricanes. On July 10th, 2021, the work began, with volunteers working alongside family members to dig the channels for the foundation of the house. On Thursday, July 22nd, Pastor Carlos (HOPE Coffee's national ministry leader in Honduras) and his wife Maria traveled to the Santos' village with Pastor Juventino to see the progress on the house. They were pleased to see the work that had been started. The foundation channels had been dug, rebar had been laid, concrete had been hand-mixed and poured into the foundation channels to form the foundation on which their house would be built. As Carlos, Maria and Juventino stood with Santos and Wendy next to their foundation shaded by banana trees, they began to share about the Solid Rock of Jesus Christ; that through His blood and His righteousness, we can place our trust in Him for our eternal salvation. Standing there by their newly completed foundation for an earthly home; both Santos and Wendy prayed to God placing their faith and trust in Jesus Christ - their foundation for a heavenly home and a relationship with Him!

Juan and Elda live in small house in the small village of San Luis Potosi, but they didn't have a proper bathroom for their family. When Pastor Brigido offered to build them one, they were very surprised and excited. And so the work began in mid-May. Arnulfo, their neighbor, became curious. He never liked Christians much.
