Ministry Update

March 28, 2022 was a special day in the life of Angeles and her daughter Danita. Pastor Carlos Lara met Angeles two years ago as he walked the Puebla, Mexico neighborhood around the church where he serves. Angeles cleans other people's houses to provide for her and her daughter, but her own house was just a simple pile of bricks with some metal pieces laying on top to provide a makeshift leaky roof. Pastor Carlos Lara and Pastor David Parra both had a desire to help this family and share the gospel with

them. So, they organized groups of people from their churches along with three other churches, and on October 19, 2021, the work began. Over the next five months, these volunteers dug and poured a proper cement foundation, mixed the mortar, laid the bricks, installed the roof, framed in the windows and doors, and painted the house.

It was slow progress, but spiritual lessons were being learned. Not only was the gospel shared throughout this time, but Angeles saw the love of Jesus from many people. Christians provided food baskets for her family, and one church member provided a pair of headphones for her daughter. When this church member came to work on the house, they noticed that it was hard to concentrate because of the loud music that played day and night from a neighbor's house. This person realized that Danita was having a hard time doing her schoolwork because of this very noisy environment. So they bought her a set of headphones to block out the noise so that she could concentrate on her school work. Danita was thrilled and saw how these Christians cared for her needs. Angeles also saw the quick "friendships" that were formed between Christians from different churches who had never met each other but who were working together as volunteers. This was something new to Angeles who was used to only deeply trusting and caring for people who earned it over a long period of time. Angeles also saw five different churches step in and help her family with the need of a proper home with the only motivation that she hears about Jesus' love for her. Everyone celebrated on March 28, 2022, when the house was completed. Danita is attending church, and she is encouraging her mother to join her. Please pray for both Angeles and Danita that they will trust in Jesus soon.

In Mexico this spring, Pastor Pedro finished a bathroom for Julio and Maria, and Pastor Enrique has started building a water cistern for Augustina. In Honduras this year, Pastor Carlos provided Rigo with some tools to help provide for his family, Pastor Walter is about to start working on a small room for a local family, and Pastor Miguel is about to start putting a new roof on a home for another family. Please pray for these pastors as they share the gospel with these families. In addition, we just learned of the salvation of Ana Rosa in Mexico. Her family is in the process of receiving a water cistern, which is being built by a local church. Pray for her spiritual growth and for the salvation of additional family members.
